Biodiversity Gain Site in Northamptonshire

This Biodiversity Gain Site is located between Markey Harborough and Corby, within the Local Planning Authority of North Northamptonshire Council and National Character Area 89 (Northamptonshire Vales)

This site contains a range of habitat types including very high distinctiveness wood pasture and parkland and high distinctiveness traditional orchards, both currently in poor condition and measures 56.54 hectares / 139.71 acres. A full Baseline Habitat Survey, Defra Metric calculations and 30-year Habitat Management and Monitoring Plan have been completed for the site. Based on this, the proposed habitat enhancements and new habitats to be created generate a total of 98.76 habitat units* in the following habitat types:
